| Morning   | <p>Visit of the Mpisi Village</p> <p><i>Twenty minutes out of the Victoria Falls town sits the Mpisi village, home to the Matabele people. The tour offers guest a first-hand glimpse into real rural life, visiting rural homes, watching fields being tended and possibly getting the chance to help in some of the day-to-day chores.</i></p>  |
| Afternoon | <p>Visit of the Falls (Zimbabwe side)</p> <p><i>The Victoria Falls constitutes one of the most spectacular natural wonders of the world. It is 1 708 meters wide, making it the largest curtain of water in the world. It drops between 90m and 107m into the Zambezi Gorge and an average of 550,000 cubic metres of water plummet over the edge every minute.</i></p> <p><i>Remarkably preserved in its natural state, the falls and the surrounding area have been declared National Parks and a World Heritage Site.</i></p> <p><i>Around two thirds of the falls are located on the Zimbabwe side and this country is also considered to have more classical views of the mains falls with footpaths leading you to breathtaking viewpoints such as Devils Cataract, Main Falls, Horseshoe Falls and the very popular Rainbow Falls.</i></p> |
